

Hi Everyone,

Please see attached new Wandelpad Maintenance plan and pic of one of the new refuse bin stickers.

Despite losing 3-4 days because of rain, the volunteer team of Basil, Anka, Peter and Ian worked well with the willing Green Team and achieved the following...

1. Plenty of weeding, removing invasive "climop" and clearing of piles debris following stormy weather and strong winds. Cleared paths with the weedeater.
2. Spruced up the garden at Stanford entrance.
3. Planted Aloes next to timber steps near King Str. and blocked off path next to the steps where cyclists were causing erosion of the bank.
4. Cut about 120 m of logs at Russell Metcalf's forest and used them to demarcate the path in the Milkwood Grove.
5. One sign has been erected to discourage people from entering the grove and another sign is on order.
6. Weeded historical graves.
7. Petronella has been very cooperative by placing more refuse drums on the Wandelpad and buying stickers for the bins. A few more bins will be placed soon. She is also trying to get refuse containers for fishing tackle and hooks plus a few bakkie loads of mulch/ wood chips for muddy paths. (The chipper is owned by the refusal disposal contractor who charges for the chips) We are still waiting for James Janse van Rensburg to supply 10 benches and 25 square meters of boardwalk.
8. The extension of the Mill Stream bridge is on hold because of high water....the bridge is currently submerged.
9. While littering is less of a problem during the winter period, dog poo is very much an ongoing problem!
